

DRAINAGE TILE OUTLET PERMIT APPLICATION

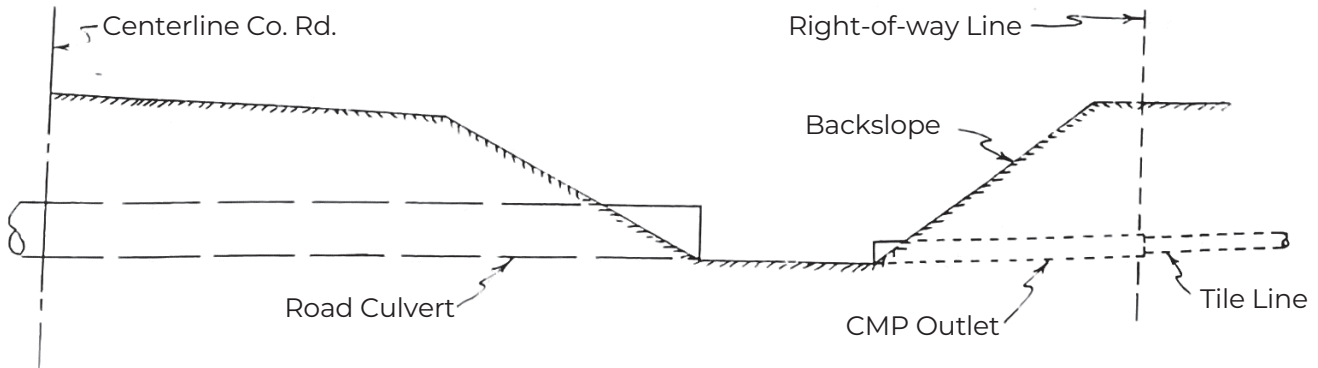
This is a permit for installation of a drainage tile outlet into a ditch within the right-of-way of a secondary road under the jurisdiction of Lucas County in accordance with Sections 319.14 and 468.622 of the Code of Iowa. The applicant agrees to comply with the following permit requirements. Compliance shall be determined by the sole discretion of the County Engineer as deemed necessary to promote public health, safety, and the general welfare. These requirements shall apply unless waived in writing by the County Engineer prior to installation. Two complete copies of this application shall be submitted to the Lucas County Engineer's Office, 916 Braden Avenue, Chariton, IA 50049.

1. The applicant shall assure that the following requirements for installation of the tile outlet have been met:
 - a. Prior to any excavation on the County's right-of-way, the applicant shall provide sufficient notice to all utility companies that may occupy the said right-of-way. **One Call 1-800-292-8989**
 - b. The tile outlet shall drain only the natural waters that would have come into the road at this location without the tile. The said tile outlet shall not drain any diverted waters from other natural waterways or sewer connections of any kind.
 - c. The tile outlet shall be placed at the tow of the backslope of the road ditch and shall not extend across the ditch or into any roadway culvert. The outlet shall not obstruct the flow of any drainage on the County's right-of-way in any manner.
 - d. The portion of the tile outlet that lies on the right-of-way of the road shall be corrugated metal pipe (CMP).
 - e. The applicant shall erect and maintain a steel post next to the tile outlet.
 - f. The applicant shall leave the right-of-way in as good condition in every way as it was before the said work was done.



2. All future maintenance of the tile outlet shall be the responsibility of the applicant or future owners of the tile system. However, before any excavation for such maintenance is done, the applicant shall gain permission from the County Engineer for any work to be done within the County right-of-way.
3. The County Engineer may halt the installation at any time if the applicant's work does not meet the requirements set forth in this permit. Non-compliant work shall be removed from the right-of-way at the applicant's own expense.

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4. The applicant shall save the County harmless of any damages resulting from the applicant's operations.
5. No applicant shall install any tile outlets on County right-of-way unless such applicant has obtained a Drainage Tile Outlet Permit from the County Engineer and has agreed in writing that said installation will comply with all requirements of the County for such work. Applicant agrees to hold the County free of liability for all damage to the applicant's property which occurs proximately as a result of the applicant's failure to comply with the requirements.
6. The applicant shall, at any time subsequent to installation of the tile outlet, at the applicant's own expense, relocate or remove such outlets as may become necessary to conform to new grades, alignments, or widening of right-of-ways resulting from maintenance or construction operations for highway improvements.
