Whereas the lump base bid price by Christner Contracting, Inc in the amount of $\$ 982,797.13$ for construction of the proposed Lucas County Conservation Pin Oak Lodge project is the lowest responsible bid received for the work and authorizing Execution. And Whereas Christner Contracting, Inc included bid prices for two (2) alternates: an ad in the amount of $\$ 12,024.00$ for Alternate \#1(install additional 2 inches of spray foam insulation to all exterior walls) and a deduct in the amount of $\$ 44,516.00$ for alternate \#2 (omission of the construction of the enclosed lean-to). The board is accepting the Alternate \#1 and rejecting the Alternate \#2 to bring the cost of the project to within the current project budget. Be it further resolved that the lump sum base bid price and Alternate \#2 deduct hereby accepted and the chair is hereby directed to execute the amount oooof $\$ 938,281.13$ with Christner Contracting, Inc for the construction of said improvements. A motion was made by Davis and seconded by Smith to pass resolution and Approve document, all voted aye. Motion carried.
