The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Lucas County Courthouse on September 3, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. with the following members present: Larry Davis, Cathy Reece and Dennis Smith. Chairman Davis called the meeting to order. A motion was made by Reece and seconded by Smith to approve agenda and deletions. All vote aye. Motion carried. A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Reece to waive reading of minutes of the previous meeting and approve as written. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Reece to approve the August 2025 Revenue Report from the Lucas County Recorder’s Office in the amount of \$5884.85. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Reece and seconded by Smith to approve the bi-monthly Expenditure Report from the Lucas County Sheriff’s Office in the amount of \$58, 002.29 from August 21, 2025, to September 3, 2025. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Reece to accept the Lucas County Audit Report from Terpstra Hoke and Associates P.C. for the year ending June 30, 2024. All vote aye. Motion carried.

William Dillard, Lucas County Veterans Affairs Director, will be increasing his workday hours to 5 hours per day and he will be replacing the flagpole at the Public Health Building.

Brett Tharp, Lucas County Sheriff, informed the Board of Supervisors he has hired a new dispatcher.

A motion was made by Reece and seconded by Smith to approve that Windstream Communications, Knoxville, IA be permitted to bury cable on County Right-of-Way in Section 24 of Benton Township, Lucas County IA. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Reece to approve Clarke Electric Cooperative of Osceola, IA be permitted to bore cable on County Road Right-of-Way in Section 15, English Township, Lucas County, IA. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Larry Davis, Lucas County Board of Supervisors Chairman stated there will be an employee cookout on Monday September 8, 2025, at the Lucas County Courthouse. Supervisor Davis also stated the recycling trailers have been receiving unacceptable items and they will be monitored more often for abuse.
