The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Lucas County Courthouse on July 1, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. with the following members present, Larry Davis and Dennis Smith. Vice- Chair Davis called the meeting to order. A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to approve the agenda as written. All voted aye. Motion carried. A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to waive reading of minutes of the previous meeting and approve as written. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to approve the bi-monthly expenditure report from the Lucas County Sheriff’s Office in the amount of \$4045.89 for the period of June 17, 2026, to June 30, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to approve the Lucas County Sheriff’s Quarterly Treasurer Report. Beginning Running Balance of \$10,970.46, Credits (Deposits) of \$36,449.79, Debits (Withdraws) of \$35,941.15 with an ending running balance of \$11,479.10. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to approve the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Appropriations Resolutions for each of the different officers and departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to approve Fiscal Year 2026-2027 salaries for the Lucas County Assessor’s office as follows: Joe Shore, Part time Clerk at \$20.50 per hour, Alyson Palmer, Lucas County Assessor, \$87,051.00 yearly salary. Kristin Benton, Luas County Deputy Assessor, \$64,998.00 yearly salary. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to approve the Resolution – Speed Limits from the Lucas County Engineer. The resolution states that all Lucas County Secondary Paved Roads will continue to have a maximum speed of 55 miles per hour.

Rebecca Bittner, Lucas County Recorder, informed the Board of Supervisors that as of July 1, 2026, the fee for Vital Records will increase.

Alyson Palmer, Lucas County Assessor, informed the Board of Supervisors that Lucas County now has an Amazon Business Account available to all offices.

A motion was made by Smith and seconded by Davis to approve claims in the amount of \$123,489.77 for the period of June 19, 2026, to July 1, 2026. All voted aye. Motion carried.
